

Special Schools and Resource Centres

You have the right to visit local special schools and schools with resource centres if you feel that it may be suitable for your child. It is always important to make sure that your child attends a school that best meets his or her needs. Below are the contact and visitation details for each school.

- **Woodland High School:** 0208 743 5668, Offers 20 minute tours on Wednesdays and Thursdays from 10am/2pm. Call in advance to book a visit.
- **Queensmill School:** 0207 385 3908
- **Queen Elizabeth II School:** 0207 641 5825/ office@qe2cp.westminster.sch.uk. You can phone or email reception for an appointment to visit the school and to speak to the headmaster. Your child must have a statement to attend this school.
- **Jack Tizard School:** 0208 735 3590/ jt@jacktizard.lbhf.sch.uk. Call or email the reception to discuss visits to the school and to speak to the headmaster.
- **Swiss Cottage School:** 0207 681 8080 (extension 2)
- **Cambridge School:** 0208 735 0980. Your child needs a statement and referral. If you call the reception you can ask to speak to the deputy head and to arrange a visit.
- **College Park School:** 0207 221 3454. You need to contact Westminster Town Hall to arrange a visit.
- **Fulham Primary School (Autistic Unit):** 0207 385 0535. You can either ask for a visit through the Local Authorities or call the reception to arrange a visit.
- **Millbank Primary School (Windmill Autistic Unit):** 0207 641 5945. Call the reception for dates of the next school tours, or you will be contacted by the head teacher when you are referred by the Local Authorities.
